

COVID-19 has been an unprecedented shock This shock to air travel has been larger and longer lasting than others


Impact of past shocks on air travel*




International air services remain low

International airport-pair routes, average flights per month




International traffic in Asia Pacific worst performing Resurgence of COVID-19 stopped further progress



Travel fell as governments imposed tighter restrictions International travel restrictions up, and domestic restrictions also rose

International travel stringency index weighted by population (Jan 2020-Jan 2021)





Key challenges for reopening borders

- Need for clear Roadmap from governments on the steps towards easing travel restrictions
- Harmonizing of Testing Certificates in accordance with recommendations of the ICAO Manual on Testing and Cross-Border Risk Management Measures
- Establishing standards for Vaccination Certifications
- Solution for the verification of COVID-19 test and vaccine status of travelers – IATA Travel Pass

National Vaccination Plan



Level 4 - High (Current)

Example general situation

- National lockdown until end-February (schools closed, nonessential businesses, work from home)
- Aggressive vaccination campaign – vulnerable & health workers as priority.

Example Aviation-specific measures

- Pre-departure testing @ STD-72hrs
- Travel corridors suspended
- Mandatory 10-day quarantine
- Travel/flight ban from highest risk countries

Level 3 - High/Moderate

- Pre-departure test retained for all arrivals @ STD-72hrs Vaccinated pax exempt.
- IATA Travel Pass digital health wallet App for verification of vaccine and/or test results
- Travel Corridors reinstated.
 Option of taking rapid test on arrival and immediate release if negative OR mandatory quarantine reduced to 5 days from departure (non-vacc pax)
- Travel/flight ban retained for highest risk countries

Level 2 - Moderate/Low

- Pre-departure test retained for arrivals STD-72 with vaccinated passengers exempted.
- IATA Travel Pass Digital health wallet expanded
- Travel Corridors expanded
- Removal of 5-day quarantine requirement for non-travel corridors countries
- Travel/flight ban option for highest risk countries

Level 1 - Low

- No predeparture test
- IATA Travel Pass Digital health wallet commonplace
- No travel corridors
- No quarantine requirement removed
- No travel or flight bans

Aspirational target:
Lift all restrictions
including quarantines
by 31 December 2021



Registry of Health Requirements

powered by Timatic

Enables passengers to find accurate information on travel, testing (and eventually vaccine) requirements for their journey.

Registry of testing / vaccination centers

Enables passengers to find testing centres and labs at their departure location which meet the standards for testing/vaccination requirements of their destination.

Lab App

Enables authorized labs and test centers to securely send test results or vaccination certificates to passengers.

IATA Travel Pass App


Enables passengers to
(1) create a 'digital passport',
(2) verify their test/vaccination meets the regulations, and
(3) share test or vaccination certificates with authorities to facilitate travel.

Can be used by travelers to manage travel documentation digitally and seamlessly throughout the travel experience.








IATA Travel Pass - Contactless Travel

Enable Contactless Travel where passengers can create a digital version of their passport, and share with airlines, airports and border authorities.

Passenger can proceed through the airport using their face as their passport and boarding pass.

Boarding Pass




Government's support needed

Enable the acceptability of IATA Travel Pass framework in the country and endorse the Travel Pass

Government's support needed:

- Remove regulatory/operational obstacles;
 Receive and issue digital certificates; Accept the test result display on the Travel Pass app
- Agree on the roadmap / long-term goal: receive information (digital identity, test/vaccination info) directly from passengers in advance
- Coordinate/cooperate with other government agencies, Health, Immigration, etc. as required





IATA will continue to work with airports to restart aviation

- IATA is committed to partnering with airports to safely restart aviation
- Ensuring strict bio-safety measures are implemented throughout the travel process, in line with ICAO CART take-off guidance
- Cooperating on passenger facilitation across check-in, boarding and arrival touchpoints which tend to become bottlenecks due to additional checks related to COVID requirements
- IATA Travel Pass and contactless processes at the airport joint efforts needed for long term changes
